STATE OF MAINE.

[S. 18.] RESOLVE in favor of Maine state library.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars in
2 addition to the sum allowed by law, be appropriated
3 for the state library, to be expended for the purchase
4 of books and incidental expenses.

Resolved, That an index and catalogue of the Maine
2 state library be made, printed and bound, under the
3 direction of the governor and council, at an expense
4 not to exceed one thousand dollars, seventy-five
5 volumes to be bound in half calf, and seventy-five
6 volumes in cloth.

Resolved, That the superintendent of public build-
2 ings be instructed under the direction of the governor
3 and council, to suitably fit up one of the ante-rooms
4 of the state building with book cases, suitably pro-
5 vided with locks, for the reception of the congressional

6 reports, and the expense thereof be charged to the
7 appropriation for public buildings.
