STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 57.] AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-six of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, entitled “an act relating to normal schools.”

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter seventy-six of the public laws of 2 eighteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby amended 3 by striking out the words “thirteen” in the fourth line 4 of section one, and in the third line of section two, and 5 inserting in said sections the word “fifteen,” so that 6 said sections shall read as follows :

7 *Sect. 1.* That for the support of the two normal 8 schools established by the state, namely, the western 9 normal school at Farmington, and the eastern normal 10 school at Castine, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars

11 is hereby annually appropriated; the same to be ex-
12 pended under the direction of the normal school trus-
13 tees, as required by act of legislature, chapter one
14 hundred and fourteen, in the year of our Lord one
15 thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.

SECT. 2. The state treasurer is hereby authorized
2 and directed to deduct from any of the school moneys
3 raised for the support of the common schools of the
4 state, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars for the pur-
5 poses indicated in this act.
