IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

[S. 49.] AN ACT to encourage the introduction of the manufacture of beet sugar.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The governor and council are hereby authorized, 2 upon such terms and conditions as they shall deem 3 advantageous to the state, to contract with any respon- 4 sible party or company to pay said party or company 5 a sum not exceeding one cent per pound, on all beet 6 sugar manufactured in this state, from beets raised in 7 this state, the amount of bounty so paid not to exceed 8 seven thousand dollars in any one year, and not to 9 exceed ten years from the time of the payment of the 10 first bounty money.
