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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

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[S. 51.] AN ACT to amend an act entitled “an act providing for division of rents of island shores to the Penobscot Indians, and for other purposes.”

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The second section of the act entitled “an act providing for division of rents of island shores to the Penobscot Indians, and for other purposes,” passed and approved February eleven, eighteen hundred and seventy-three, being chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the laws of that year, is hereby amended in the third line of the second section thereof by striking out the word “thirty” and inserting the word “ten,” so that said third line shall read “the period of ten days after the same by the terms of the lease,” &c.
