STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-four of the revised statutes, relating to the settlement of paupers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Clause III of section one of said chap-
- 2 ter twenty-four, shall be amended, by striking out
- 3 the words "at the time of their birth," so that the
- 4 said clause, as amended, shall read as follows:
- 5 III. Children legitimate or illegitimate, do not ac-
- 6 quire a settlement by birth in the town where they are
- 7 born. Illegitimate have the settlement of their mother,
- 8 but where the parents of such children born after March
- 9 twenty-fourth, eighteen hundred sixty-four, intermarry
- 10 they are deemed legitimate and have the settlement of
- 11 their father.

- 12 Strike out from clause VI of said section one, the
- 13 words "five successive years," and insert in place
- 14 thereof the words 'two successive years,' so that the
- 15 clause as amended shall read as follows:
- 16 VI. A person of age having his home in a town two
- 17 successive years without receiving, directly or in-
- 18 directly, supplies as a pauper, has a settlement therein.
- 19 Also strike out from clause VIII. in said section, the
- 20 words "five" wherever it occurs, and insert instead
- 21 thereof, the word 'two,' so that the clause as amended
- 22 shall read as follows:
- 23 VIII. Persons having their homes in an unincor-
- 24 porated place for two years without receiving supplies
- 25 as a pauper, and having continued their home there to
- 26 the time of its incorporation, acquire a settlement
- 27 therein. Those having homes in such places less than
- 28 two years before incorporation, and continuing to have
- 29 them there afterwards until two years are completed,
- 30 acquire a settlement therein.
 - SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
 - 2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed, saving
 - 3 all suits pending and all supplies furnished before the
 - 4 time this act shall take effect.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
