RESOLVE in favor of the town of Madawaska.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be
2 and is hereby appropriated and paid to the treasurer
3 of the town of Madawaska, when the county commis-
4 sioners of the county of Aroostook shall certify to the
5 state treasurer that a good and substantial bridge has
6 been built over the Martin stream, so called, in said
7 town of Madawaska.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The facts are as follows: There are some eight bridges on the county road, on the bank of the St. John river, in the town of Madawaska, and the town is unable to build all these bridges, and your Committee have adjudged that the State should assist the town.
