STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Frenchville.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be 2 and is hereby appropriated and paid to the treasurer 3 of the town of Frenchville, to aid in building a bridge 4 over the Rossignal stream, so called, in said town, in 5 the county of Aroostook; the same to be paid out of 6 the state treasury to the treasurer of said town, when 7 the county commissioners of Aroostook shall certify 8 that a good and substantial bridge has been built 9 over said stream.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This town has many bridges on the county road, and are so burthened with bridges and new roads to construct, that your Committee thought the State should assist them.
