## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to abolish the August term of the supreme judicial court in the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section seventeen, chapter seventy-2 seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by 3 striking out the words, "in the county of Kennebec, 4 at Augusta, on the first Tuesdays of March and 5 August and the third Tuesday of October," and insert-6 ing in place thereof the words, "in the county of 7 Kennebec, at Augusta, on the first Tuesday of March 8 and the third Tuesday of October."

SECT. 2. No criminal business shall be transacted at 2 any of the terms of the supreme judicial court, held

3 within and for said county of Kennebec, after the 4 next October term thereof.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
