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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

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AN ACT to abolish the August term of the supreme judicial court in the county of Kennebec.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section seventeen, chapter seventy-  
2 seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by  
3 striking out the words, “in the county of Kennebec,  
4 at Augusta, on the first Tuesdays of March and  
5 August and the third Tuesday of October,” and insert-  
6 ing in place thereof the words, “in the county of  
7 Kennebec, at Augusta, on the first Tuesday of March  
8 and the third Tuesday of October.”

SECT. 2. No criminal business shall be transacted at  
2 any of the terms of the supreme judicial court, held

3 within and for said county of Kennebec, after the  
4 next October term thereof.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
