## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE entitled “resolve in favor of Baring and Houlton road across Indian township and Grand Lake stream road, in Washington county.”

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars be  
2 appropriated to be expended on that of the Houlton  
3 and Baring road which lies in the Indian township ;  
4 also, that the sum of two hundred dollars be appro-  
5 priated to be expended on the road leading from Houl-  
6 ton and Baring road in said Indian township to Grand  
7 Lake stream ; said sums to be expended under the  
8 supervision of the governor and council.

The State annually makes an appropriation for the road leading through the Indian township.
