RESOLVE entitled "resolve in favor of Baring and Houlton road across Indian township and Grand Lake stream road, in Washington county."

Resolved. That the sum of three hundred dollars be

- 2 appropriated to be expended on that of the Houlton
- 3 and Baring road which lies in the Indian township;
- 4 also, that the sum of two hundred dollars be appro-
- 5 priated to be expended on the road leading from Houl-
- 6 ton and Baring road in said Indian township to Grand
- 7 Lake stream; said sums to be expended under the
- 8 supervision of the governor and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The State annually makes an appropriation for the road leading through the Indian township.
