STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section twelve of chapter one hundred
and thirty-three of the public laws of eighteen hundred
and seventy-three, relating to the jail system of the
state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-
2 three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
3 seventy-three, is hereby amended, so as to read as
4 follows :

5 *Sect. 12.* The keeper of the jail in the several
6 counties, shall keep a record of the conduct of each
7 convict, and for every month it appears by such record
8 that such convict has faithfully observed all the rules

9 and requirements of the prison, such convict shall be
10 entitled to a deduction from his sentence according to
11 and not exceeding the following rate and proportion :
12 For a convict under sentence for six months and less
13 than one year, two days for each month of good con-
14 duct ; for one year and over, three days per month ;
15 and for every day any convict shall be punished for
16 disobedience of the rules of said jail, a record thereof
17 shall be made, and two days deducted therefor from
18 any commutations to which he may be entitled.
