STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and eighteen of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, relating to savings banks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eight of chapter two hundred and eighteen of

- 2 the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven,
- 3 "an act to revise and consolidate the laws relating to the
- 4 government, powers, duties, privileges and liabilities
- 5 of savings banks and institutions for savings," is
- 6 amended, by inserting after the word "located" in the
- 7 fourth line of said section, the words "or of an adja-
- 8 cent county," so that said section, as amended, shall
- 9 read as follows:

20 the corporation.

10 Sect. 8. Every such corporation shall consist of not 11 less than thirty members, and may, at any legal meet- 12 ing, by a majority of at least two-thirds of those 13 present, elect by ballot any citizen of the county 14 wherein the corporation is located, or of an adjacent 15 county, to be a member thereof. No person shall con- 16 tinue to be a member after removing from the state. 17 Any member of the corporation who shall fail to attend 18 the annual meetings for two successive years, shall 19 cease to be a member, unless re-elected by a vote of
