STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-six of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes, relating to the weight of corn and grain, meal, vegetables and hair.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section fifty-six of chapter thirty-eight
2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "sixty-four," after the word "beans,"
4 in the seventh line of said section, and inserting in
5 place thereof the words "sixty-two."

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
