STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter fifty-eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to auctioneers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section one of chapter fifty-eight of the
- 2 public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, is
- 3 hereby amended in the second line, by striking out the
- 4 words "suitable inhabitants," and inserting instead
- 5 thereof the words "legal voter," so said section, as
- 6 amended, shall read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 1. The municipal officers of any town may
- 8 license any legal voter of their town, by a writing
- 9 under their hands, to be auctioneers for one year, in

- 10 any town in said county; and shall record every such
- 11 license in a book kept by them for that purpose. Per-
- 12 sons so licensed may be exempted from any liability
- 13 to deduct two and one-half per cent. from the gross
- 14 amount of sales, as provided in section three of chapter
- 15 thirty-four of revised statutes.
 - SECT. 2. Persons so licensed, shall upon receipt of
 - 2 such license, pay to the treasurer of said town the sum
 - 3 of two dollars, and by him paid into the treasury for
 - 4 the use of the town where such license is granted.
