RESOLVE in favor of a road leading from Kingfield to  
Eustis.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of five hundred dollars be  
2 and is hereby appropriated to repair the road leading  
3 from Kingfield to Eustis, the same to be expended  
4 under direction of the county commissioners.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

---

It appeared by evidence before the Committee, that the road from Kingfield to Eustis, is through a tract of unsettled country; that the road has fallen into such a state as to render it unsafe for travel, and that the towns and county were not able to put it in thorough repair.
