Amendments proposed by Mr. PARLIN of North Anson, to
Document No. 23, entitled "An Act to facilitate the prompt
administration of justice by establishing a Superior Court in the
County of Kennebec."

AMENDMENT "A."

Section six be amended, by adding to the thirty-
2 seventh line, after the word "cause," the words :
3 "and in no case shall a plaintiff recover for travel and
4 attendance for more than two terms."

AMENDMENT "B."

Section fourteen be amended, by adding to said sec-
2 tion, after the word "quarterly," the words : "From
3 the county treasury of Kennebec county."
