STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Cyrus T. Daniels.

Resolved, That the land agent is hereby authorized
2 to convey to Cyrus T. Daniels lot number one hundred
3 thirty-eight, in Chapman plantation, on receiving in
4 addition to the road labor already paid, fifteen dollars
5 in cash, and satisfactory evidence that said Daniels is
6 the lawful owner of the certificate of said lot.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

I, Cyrus T. Daniels of Presque Isle, Me., the undersigned, respectfully represent that I am the true and lawful owner of lot No. 138, in Chapman plantation, Aroostook county, Maine; that I have performed all the road labor in payment for said lot, and before I had done the remaining settling duties as required by law, a heavy fire, in the month of July, A. D. 1877, swept over that portion of the plantation, and killed all the timber then standing and growing on the said lot, which will be worthless unless taken off the present season; that it is not possible for me to complete the remaining settling duties within that time, and all the burnt timber will be a total loss if the said lot is not deeded, so the same may be taken off the present logging season. Therefore I ask that an act be passed the present session, authorizing the Land Agent to deed said lot to me, waiving further settling duties, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
