RESOLVE in favor of Freeman Hayden.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to con-

- 2 vey to Freeman Hayden lot number eighty-six in town-
- 3 ship number eleven, range three, west from the east
- 4 line of the state, on receiving payment therefor at the
- 5 rate of fifty cents per acre in road labor, and twenty
- 6 cents additional thereto in cash, and becomes satisfied
- 7 that said Hayden is the lawful owner of the certificate
- 8 of said lot.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled:

We the undersigned, respectfully represent that lot No. (86) eighty-six, in Chapman plantation, in Aroostook County, is a swamp lot unfit for settling; that all the road labor has been done in payment for said lot by Freeman Hayden, who is now the owner of the same by virtue of an assignment of the land certificate issued therefor, to Daniel Lothrop. Wherefore we ask that an act be passed the present session, authorizing the Land Agent to deed said lot to him, waiving further settling duties, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
