RESOLVE in favor of Ezekiel Levasseur.

---

*Resolved,* That the land agent be authorized to convey to Ezekiel Levasseur, lot number thirty-five, in township I, range two, Aroostook county, on payment by said Levasseur of fifty cents per acre in road labor and twenty cents per acre additional thereto in cash, provided said Levasseur shall prove that he is the lawful holder of the land certificate of said lot.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

---

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

The undersigned, citizens of Caribou, in the State of Maine, would respectfully represent that Ezekiel LeVasseur of said town, owns and occupies lots numbered 34 and 35, in that part of said town formerly I township, as his homestead farm, that he lives upon lot No. 34, but that his barn and a quarter part of his farm is upon lot No. 35 ; that he has paid the State for said lot 35, and wishes the Land Agent to be instructed and empowered to deed to him said lot, waiving all further settling duties, as said lot is indispensable to his farm, there being no living water upon the lot upon which he now lives, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
