STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Lydia A. Daniels.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Lydia A. Daniels, lot number one hundred forty-six, in Chapman plantation, on receiving in addition to the road labor already paid, fifteen dollars in cash, and proving that she is the lawful owner of the certificate of said lot.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

I, Lydia A. Daniels of Presque Isle, Me., respectfully represent that I am the owner of lot No. 146, in Chapman plantation, that I have done all the road labor in payment for said lot; that a heavy fire swept over said lot in July, 1877, and killed all the growing timber thereon; that the said timber will be worthless unless taken off the coming winter, and I am unable to perform the remaining settling duties within that time, in order to procure deed under Settlers' act; wherefore, I ask that an act may be passed during the present session, authorizing the Land Agent to deed said lot to me, waiving further settling duties, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
