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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE authorizing the conveyance of a lot of land in  
Crystal plantation.

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*Resolved,* That the land agent be authorized to convey to the lawful holder of the certificate of the southwest part of section fifty-two in Crystal plantation, Aroostook county, on receiving payment therefor at the rate of fifty cents per acre in road labor, and twenty cents per acre additional thereto in cash.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

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To the Land Agent, Augusta, Me.

I, the undersigned, Local Agent for the Plantation of Crystal, Aroostook county, Me., represent that the settling duties on S. W. part sec. 52, Township 4, R. 5, are all done except five acres that is chopped and burned, but not seeded to grass. Also that the road labor has all been done except about two days, which I will see that it is done this season for a certainty.
