STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Mrs. Ellebert Michaud.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury
2 to Mrs. Ellebert Michaud, the sum of one hundred
3 three dollars and three cents, for money paid by her
4 husband, Ellebert Michaud, deceased, for lot numbered
5 forty-three, in Wallagrass plantation, July eleven,
6 eighteen hundred forty-nine, and interest thereon, said
7 lot having been awarded to said Ellebert Michaud
8 under the treaty of Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1849, Ellebert Michaud paid for lot 43, in cash, to the State of Maine and Massachusetts, and the same lot was awarded to said Michaud by Commissioners under Treaty of Washington. The State of Maine received from the General Government payment for the lot at the rate of \$1.25 per acre.
