STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Shepard I. Higgins.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to Shepard I. Higgins lot number five, in township number eleven, range three, west from the east line of the state, on receiving, in addition to the road labor already paid, twenty cents per acre in cash and satisfactory evidence that said Higgins is the lawful holder of the certificate of said lot.
