STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Eugene Michaud.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury

- 2 to Eugene Michaud, the sum of one hundred thirty-
- 3 two dollars and thirty cents, for money paid by said
- 4 Michaud for lot numbered forty-four in Wallagrass
- 5 plantation, July eleven, eighteen hundred forty-nine,
- 6 and interest thereon, said lot having been awarded to
- 7 said Michaud under the treaty of Washington.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In 1849, Eugene Michaud bought of the States of Maine and Massachusetts, lot 44, in township No. 17, range 7, and paid the money, and the Commissioners under the Treaty of Washington awarded said lot to said Michaud. The State of Maine received from the General Government payment for the lot at \$1.25 per acre.
