STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to carry into effect the provisions of chapter forty-nine of the resolves of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to purchase for cash the land described in resolve authorizing the land agent to exchange other land of equal value for a settling lot in township K, range two, Aroostook county, at a price not exceeding one dollar per acre, and convey the same to Desire Violette or assigns, upon the performance of the duties required by said resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The proprietors will not exchange for land in another township.
