STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT in relation to disorganized towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. In all cases when towns are or may be 2 disorganized by a repeal of their organic charter, and 3 their debts and liabilities are excepted and reserved 4 by the provisions of the act repealing the same, legal 5 service of processes to collect such debts and liabilities 6 may be made on any inhabitant of lawful age resident 7 of the territory included in said disorganized town, in 8 same manner as provided for service of such process 9 against towns; *provided*, there are no legal officers 10 in said territory on which legal service can be made.

SECT. 2. This act shall apply to school districts in 2 said disorganized towns, so far as the same is appli-3 cable. • .
