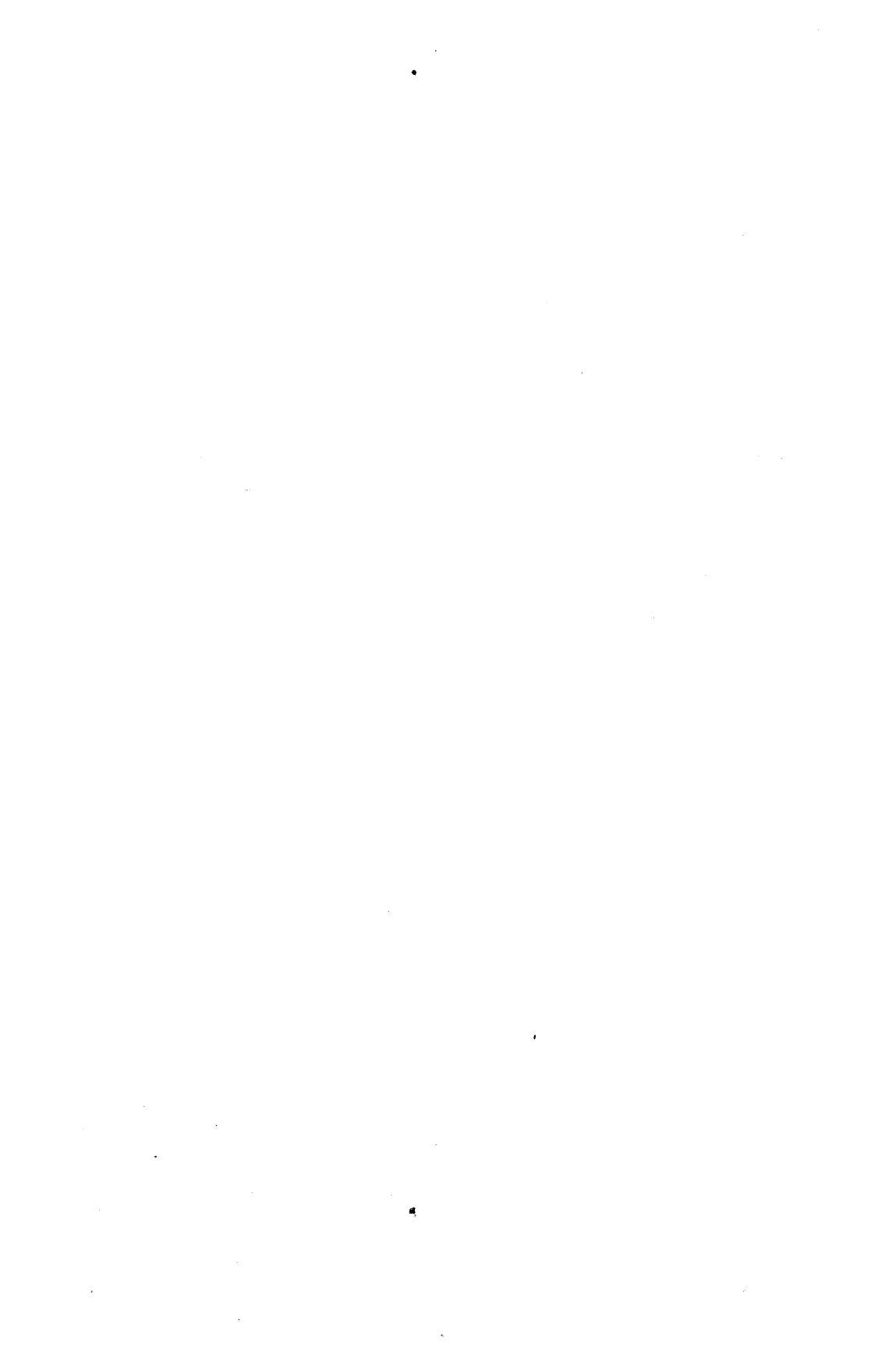

SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to prevent the killing of deer in the county of
Waldo.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

No person shall hunt or kill any deer on any lands in
2 the county of Waldo, for the period of ten years,
3 under the same penalties as are provided in section
4 nine of chapter thirty of the revised statutes.
