## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter ninety-five of the revised statutes, relating to actions of trespass.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter ninety-five of the revised

- 2 statutes, is amended, by adding after the word "land"
- 3 in the first line, the words "door-yard, ornamental
- 4 grounds;" and by adding after the word "any" in the
- 5 second line, the words "cuts down, defaces, destroys,
- 6 or;" and by adding after the word "vegetable" in the
- 7 third line, the words "ornamental trees;" and by ad-
- 8 ding after the word "so" in the fourth line, the words
- 9 "cut down, defaced, destroyed, or," so that said sec-
- 10 tion, as amended, shall read as follows:

- 11 Sect. 11. If any person enters on any grass land,
- 12 door-yard, ornamental grounds, orchard or garden,
- 13 and cuts down, defaces, destroys, or takes therefrom,
- 14 without permission of the owner, any grass, hay, fruit,
- 15 vegetables, ornamental trees or shrubs, he shall be
- 16 liable to the party injured in a sum equal to three
- 17 times the value of the articles so cut down, defaced,
- 18 destroyed, or taken away, in an action of trespass.
