STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Mayfield.

Resolved, That three hundred dollars be appropriated
2 to assist the town of Mayfield in building a road lead-
3 ing from Brighton Center to Kingsbury Mills, through
4 said town of Mayfield, the same to be expended under
5 the direction of the county commissioners of Somerset
6 county ; provided that said town of Mayfield shall
7 raise and expend an equal sum on said road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, at Augusta :

We, the undersigned, inhabitants of the town of Mayfield, in the county of Somerset, would respectfully represent to your honorable body that a road has been laid out by the County Commissioners of Somerset and Piscataquis counties, in joint Board assembled, leading from Brighton Center, in Somerset county, to Kingsbury Mills, in Piscataquis county; that nearly one and three-fourth miles of said road is within the limits of said town of Mayfield, and required to be built by said town; that it will require a large sum of money to properly construct said road; that the said town of Mayfield has but few inhabitants and a small amount of taxable property, and is already largely in debt, and would be greatly embarrassed and overburdened if compelled to build said road from its own resources. We therefore respectfully pray that your honorable body will appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars to aid the said town of Mayfield in the construction of said road.
