RESOLVE in favor of John S. Arnold.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to John S. Arnold, lot number twenty-three, in Woodland plantation, for thirty-five cents per acre in cash.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This lot, No. 23, is a low swamp lot, except a few acres on one corner ; and would have been put into the State sale of swamp land in Woodland plantation, but for a small improvement on this corner by one Gustof Chewiaits, a Sweed, whose quitclaim deed of the premises accompanies this statement and petition.

To the Hon. Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled.

The undersigned respectfully asks your honorable body to authorize the Land Agent to deed to him, lot No. 23, in Woodland plantation, Aroostook county, upon the payment of thirty-five cents in road labor, or cash, per acre. As in duty bound will ever pray.
