RESOLVE in favor of L. D. and H. P. Todd.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to L. D. and H. P. Todd, lot number forty-six in Eaton Grant, Aroostook county, waiving further settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Hon. Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

L. D. Todd and H. P. Todd respectfully represent, that they hold certificates of lot No. 46 (Gore lot) in that part of Caribou formerly Eaton Grant ; the said L. D. Todd owning the north half, and the said H. P. Todd the south half of said lot ; that said lot adjoins the homestead lots or farms of said Todds, and cultivated as parts of their farms, to wit, lots Nos. 80 and 85 ; that upon said lot No. 46 they had the amount of thirty acres of grain last year, beside pasture land improved ; that said lot is paid for to the State ; that they have a barn upon said lot, 40 by 40 feet ; that they desire and expect to keep said lot as part of said homestead farm. They therefore pray that the Land Agent be authorized and instructed to convey said lot to said L. D. Todd and said H. P. Todd, waiving further settling duties.
