STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of William Reed.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to William Reed lot number sixty-two, in township number eleven, range one, west from the east line of the state, on payment by said Reed of fifty cents per acre in road labor, and twenty cents per acre additional thereto in cash.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

That Robert W. Davis purchased lot No. 62 from the State by certificate, June 9, 1874, and resided on the same till January 26, 1875, when William Reed purchased said Davis' rights and improvements to said lot, and since said purchase has paid the State the amount due the State in labor on the roads; also that said Reed has been assessed and paid the taxes on the improvement of said lot the last three years.
