AN ACT to abolish the office of crier in the various courts of the state.

The place of crier in the various courts of this state, 2 is hereby abolished, and the duties heretofore perform-3 ed by that officer, shall hereafter be performed by the 4 sheriff and the clerk of the courts under the direction 5 of the court.
