STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to abolish the office of crier in the various courts
of the state.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The place of crier in the various courts of this state,
2 is hereby abolished, and the duties heretofore perform-
3 ed by that officer, shall hereafter be performed by the
4 sheriff and the clerk of the courts under the direction
5 of the court.
