STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter sixty of revised statutes, relating to actions of divorce.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter sixty of the revised

- 2 statutes, is hereby amended by adding after the word
- 3 "court" in the first line, the words "or any justice
- 4 thereof in vacation," so that said section as amended
- 5 shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 5. Pending a libel, the court, or any justice
- 7 thereof in vacation, may order the husband to pay the
- 8 clerk, for the wife, a suitable sum of money for her
- 9 defence, or prosecution thereof, and to make reason-
- 10 able provision for her separate support, enter such
- 11 decree for the care and custody of the minor children

- 12 as they think right; and enforce obedience by appro-13 priate processes.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on approval.
