STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT in relation to the duties of county attorneys
and additional to chapter seventy-nine of the revised
statutes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

It shall be the duty of each county attorney to appear
2 and act for the state with the attorney general, in the
3 law court of his district, in all state cases coming into
4 said court from his county.
