IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT relating to coroners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Coroners, when holding inquests, have 2 the same authority as probate courts to compel the 3 attendance of witnesses; and may commit for con-4 tempt.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
