STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on the several counties of the
state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties in
2 the following schedule, are hereby granted as a tax on
3 each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed,
4 collected and applied for the purpose of paying the
5 debts and necessary expenses of the same, and other
6 purposes ordered by law, to wit :

7 Androscoggin, thirty thousand dollars; Aroostook,
8 fourteen thousand five hundred dollars; Cumberland,
9 sixty-eight thousand dollars; Franklin, seventy-five
10 hundred dollars; Hancock, sixteen thousand dollars;
11 Knox, fifteen thousand five hundred dollars;
12 Kennebec, forty thousand dollars; Lincoln, nine
13 thousand dollars; Oxford, thirteen thousand dol-
14 lars; Penobscot, fifty-eight thousand dollars; Piscata-

15 quis, seven thousand dollars; Sagadahoc, eighteen thousand dollars; Somerset, twelve thousand dollars; 17 Washington, sixteen thousand dollars; Waldo, eighteen thousand dollars; York, twenty-five thousand dollars.
