RESOLVE making an appropriation for the Penobscot tribe of Indians, for repairs on chapel on Oldtown island.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury,

- 2 to the agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, to be
- 3 appropriated for making repairs on the chapel on Old-
- 4 town island, one hundred and forty-four dollars and
- 5 thirty-five cents, being the unexpended balance of the
- 6 appropriations for the Penobscot tribe of Indians for
- 7 the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.
