STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of William D. Orr.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to convey to William D. Orr the north half of lot number seventy-three in township number four, range four, west from the east line of the state, waiving settling duties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled :

The undersigned would respectfully represent that in 1867 he applied for a certificate for one-half of lot 73 in township No. 4, R. 4, Aroostook County, State of Maine, said lot being a swamp or meadow lot. The certificate was forwarded Nov. 28, 1867, but filled out for a settling lot, contrary to the application and not according to the facts in the case. Your petitioner paid for said lot, as will appear by the Land Office books, and on asking for a deed was told by Land Agent, P. P. Burleigh, that there was a mistake in filing the certificate, that it did not agree with the application, and he could not grant a deed. The purport of this petition is to ask your honorable body to authorize the Land Agent to issue a deed agreeable to the facts in the case.
