## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to abate the state tax in Washington plantaton in Franklin county, for the years eighteen hundred seventy-five, eighteen hundred seventy-six and eighteen hundred seventy-seven.

Resolved, That the state tax assessed on Washington

- 2 plantation in Franklin county, for the years eighteen
- 3 hundred seventy-five, eighteen hundred seventy-six
- 4 and eighteen hundred seventy-seven, amounting to
- 5 fifty-five dollars and eighteen cents, be and hereby is
- 6 abated.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The organization of the plantation has run down. They have no schools, no right of voting, and the inhabitants are so few in number that they do not feel able to keep up and maintain an organization. If the organization had been kept up, the plantation would have received \$132.00 from the State for support of schools, which is a sum in excess of their tax for the three years of \$76.82.
