STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Jeanne M. Strickland.

Resolved, That the land agent be authorized to locate

- 2 and convey to Jeanne M. Strickland, a lot of land not
- 3 exceeding two hundred acres, from any township in
- 4 which lands are owned by the state, to be in full pay-
- 5 ment of her claim as assignee of the rights granted to
- 6 Gowen Wilson by chapter one hundred and eighty-four
- 7 of the resolves of eighteen hundred and forty-nine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

By "Resolve in favor of Gowen Wilson," approved August 13, 1849, the Land Agent was authorized to convey to him a lot of land in Township F, Range 2, W. E. L. S. Wilson by his deed dated May 10, 1850, recorded in Aroostook Registry of Deeds in Vol. 15, Page 508, conveyed all his rights under said resolve to John McCluskey of Houlton, and it does not appear by the records in the Land Office that McCluskey nor any other person has ever received conveyance of any land under said resolve. Said McCluskey entered the army in 186-, as Col. of the 15th Regiment of Maine Volunteers, and died in 186-. Mrs. Strickland is his sole surviving heir.
