RESOLVE in favor of building a bridge in township
seventeen, range eight in Aroostook county.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars be
2 and is hereby appropriated to build a bridge in town-
3 ship number seventeen, range eight, the same to be
4 expended under the direction of the county commis-
5 sioners of Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It was in evidence that the bridge near Raymond Daigle's is broken down, and unsafe for public travel. That this bridge is on the mail route from Fort Kent to St. Francis, but the inhabitants of said plantation are not able to repair said bridge.
