STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section seven, chapter four of revised statutes, relating to voting lists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seven, chapter four of the revised statutes, 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following 3 words: "Except such as have before been on the list 4 and have been inadvertently omitted by the selectmen; 5 and no change shall be made in names on that day 6 except to correct clerical errors therein," so that the 7 section as amended shall read follows:

8 In all towns having one thousand or more registered 9 voters, the municipal officers thereof shall receive ap-10 plications of persons claiming a right to vote, on the

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11 three secular days next preceding the day of election, 12 and no application shall be received after the hour of 13 five of the clock in the afternoon on the secular day 14 next preceding said day of election; and no name shall 15 be added to the list of voters on the day of election by 16 certificate or otherwise, except such as have before 17 been on the list and have been inadvertently omitted 18 by the selectmen; and no change shall be made in 19 names except to correct clerical errors therein.
