Amendment proposed by Mr. PILSBURY of Lewiston, to House Document No. 94, entitled "An Act to amend chapter 218 of the public laws of 1877, entitled 'an act to revise and consolidate the laws relating to the government, powers, duties, privileges and iabilities of savings banks and institutions for savings."

Amend by striking out the words "one-half" in the 2 nineteenth line, and the same words in the twenty-3 second line of said section 15 of chapter 218 of the 4 public laws of 1877, and inserting the words "two-5 thirds" in said nineteenth line; and the words "one-6 third" in the twenty-second line, so that said section, 7 as amended, shall read: "The treasurer shall pay to the 8 treasurer of the state, a tax on account of its deposits, 9 of three-quarters of one per centum per annum on the 10 amount of its deposits as in said return. Two-thirds 11 of said tax to be assessed on the average amount on 12 deposit for the six months ending and including the 13 last Saturday in April, and the other one-third on the 14 average on deposit for the six months ending and in-15 cluding the last Saturday in April."
