## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to provide schools for the training of teachers in Madawaska territory.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The trustees of the normal schools are
- 2 hereby authorized to establish and maintain, for a pe-
- 3 riod not less than six months in each year, two schools
- 4 in Madawaska territory, so called, for the purpose of
- 5 training persons to teach in the common schools of
- 6 said territory. The towns in which such schools may
- 7 be located shall furnish suitable buildings therefor, free
- 8 of expense, and shall also furnish fuel for said schools.
- 9 The choice of books and teachers for said schools, the
- 10 course of study to be pursued therein, and the grade

- 11 of scholarship for admission thereto, shall be under
- 12 the control of said trustees.
  - Sect. 2. To defray the expenses of said schools the
  - 2 sum of one thousand dollars is hereby appropriated in
  - 3 the manner hereinafter provided. The treasurer of
  - 4 the state shall annually deduct from the gross amount
  - 5 of the state school funds of all description annually
  - 6 apportioned to the towns of Grand Isle, Frenchville,
  - 7 Madawaska and Fort Kent, and from the plantations of
  - 8 Hamlen, Connor, Cyr, Van Buren, St. Francis, St.
  - 9 John, Wallagrass, and Eagle Lake, one thousand dol-
- 10 lars, which sum shall remain in the state treasury sub-
- 11 ject to the order of the governor and council for the
- 12 payment of the expenses of said schools, the bills for
- 13 which shall be approved by the state superintendent of
- 14 common schools, and audited by the governor and
- 15 council.
