STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to encourage the provision of means for the
extinguishment of fires.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The aqueducts, pipes and conduits of
2 any corporation, engaged in supplying any city or
3 town with water, shall be exempt from taxation, when
4 any city or town shall take from the aqueducts, pipes
5 or conduits of such corporations, water for the extin-
6 guishment of fires, without charge being made for the
7 same.

SECT. 2. Nothing in this act shall be so construed
2 as to include in this exemption the capital stock of
3 such corporation, any reservoir or grounds occupied

4 for the same, or any property, real or personal, owned
5 by such company or corporation, other than as enum-
6 erated in section one.
