STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of refuse into the tributaries of Wilson pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner of 2 mills on the streams of water flowing into Wilson pond 3 in the city of Auburn, or any person or persons em-4 ployed in or about said mills, to cast or throw any 5 shavings, sawdust or other rubbish into the waters of 6 said streams, or allow the same to be deposited in 7 such a manner that it may be washed therein.

SECT. 2. If any person or persons shall violate the 2 provisions of section one of this act, he or they shall 3 be subject to a fine or penalty of not more than fifty

4 dollars nor less than ten dollars upon complaint and

5 conviction before any courts of competent jurisdiction.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on approval.
