STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-EIGHT.

AN ACT to amend section eight (8) of chapter one
hundred and twenty of the revised statutes relating to
larceny.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled,* as follows:

Said section is hereby amended by adding at the end
2 thereof the following: “and any insurance agent, or
3 agent of any corporation, doing business in this state,
4 who shall appropriate to his own use any money or
5 substitute for money received by him as such agent or
6 shall refuse or neglect to pay over and deliver the
7 same to the party entitled to receive it for the space
8 of thirty days after written demand upon him therefor,
9 shall be deemed guilty of larceny and punished accord-
10 ingly.
